



In the The Oakley model, deep colours and warm neutrals create a space suitable for grown-ups By Lisa Van de Ven

A place for the adults to come out and play. That's what Jane Lockhart wanted to create in The Oakley model at Parkside East: a space where kids may be welcome, but that the adults could truly enjoy. "We used the Montreal bistro as our inspiration, with deeper colours and darker finishes, and a lot of details on the walls," says the designer, of Jane Lockhart Interior Design. Browns, taupes and grey/beige blends create a neutral backdrop for the 3,518-square-foot home, but Ms. Lockhart didn't shy away from colour either, blending in apricot, pumpkin and antique gold. "I always like neutrals mixed in with new colours; it makes people much more accepting," she says. Homes at the Kylemore Communities site range from 2,200 to 4,088 square feet and from \$989,990 to \$1,389,990. The designer embraced darker tones throughout the home, using a brown-taupe : hue on the living room walls to contrast with the white wainscotting below. A bonus: "The light wainscotting allows you to from her Jane by Jane Lockhart : have darker furniture, because now that furniture is all against a light background," she adds.

> "It's big. It sits a lot of people," Ms. Lockhart says of the maple table she chose for the dining room. While it may be large, though, it's not overly formal: the casual, clean-lined design is perfect for when family comes into town.

Looking for something substantial to take a central position in the living room, Ms. Lockhart chose this coffee table from Union Lighting and Furnishings. It features a central inlay design and mother-of-pearl details. "It's classic," she says. "It's got a Ralph Lauren quality to it."

Two black iron light fixtures from Union Lighting hang above the dining room table, their open design leaving views to the art on the walls no matter where you sit. "Putting in two adds drama and gives enough light in the bigger space," Ms. Lockhart adds.
